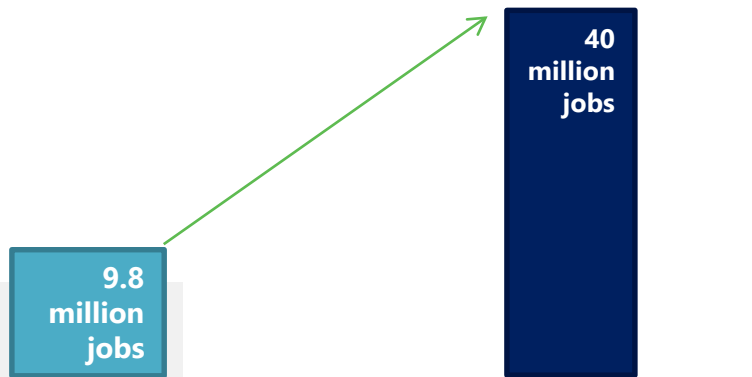

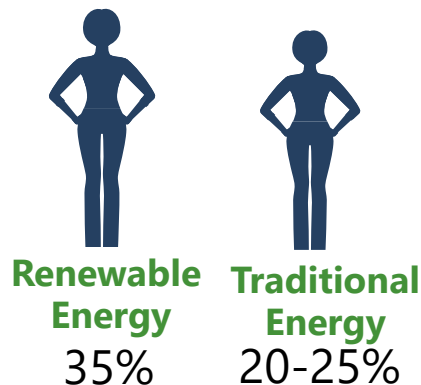

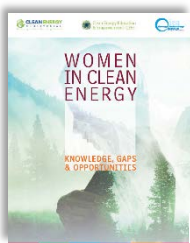

THE EQUAL BY 30 CAMPAIGN

Equal by 30 is a public commitment by **public and private sector organizations** to work towards **equal pay**, **equal leadership** and **equal opportunities** for women in the sector by 2030.

Equal by 30 asks companies and governments to **endorse principles**, then **take concrete action** to accelerate the participation of women in the clean energy sector, and close the gender gap.

The campaign is **spearheaded by Canada**, who oversee engagement, branding, outreach and coordination. The IEA and Sweden play supporting roles, and lead on engagement with international signatories.



Equal by 30 activities since CEM9:

- 1 LAUNCHED** At a CEM9 side event, showcasing initial signatories, including Italy, Finland, Sweden and Canada
- 2 ENDORSED** By all G7 countries at the Energy Minister's Meeting in Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada
- 3 INTEGRATED** Into the formal C3E Programme of Work, making it a fifth and more permanent work stream
- 4 PROGRESS** Currently has 89 private sector signatories globally, alongside 9 CEM-member country signatories
